


STEP 2: TAKE A TOUR

- Veterans Assistance: We offer loans, grants, and scholarships to veterans who qualify. Call our school to learn more about what may be available to you.
- Payment Plans: Make your education possible by setting up a payment plan that works for you. Talk with one of our advisors to learn more.

STEP 4: APPLY TO THE PROGRAM

You're ready to apply! Every school has a unique application process so be sure to contact a school representative if you're unsure where to start. At Aveda Institute Boise and Aveda Institute Twin Falls, your application process starts by scheduling an appointment with our admissions counselor to talk about options, programs, and financial aid. Next, you'll submit your application, along with:

- An entrance essay
- A letter of recommendation
- A valid ID
- Copies of your high school diploma/ transcripts

Your application will be reviewed by an admissions specialist. If accepted, you will sign a school contract, pay a registration fee, and be on your way!

Your first day at either of our campuses will start with a morning huddle. Here we go over our school mission and wellness, do introductions and a fun fact, and then break off into classes.

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From there, you will attend a mandatory orientation along with other new students, and meet one-on-one with our director to enroll in the business office.

Once enrollment is taken care of, you will play a few icebreaker games to get to know your classmates. Then you will go through the program curriculum, including what you will be learning and classroom expectations.

After, you will get to begin practicing our essentials curriculum hands-on! Future in beauty, here you come.
